

Family Literacy Workshops

Each month the NWT Literacy Council will host a free Saturday afternoon workshop. These workshops would be great for Early Childhood workers, teachers, parents and anyone involved in Family Literacy. The workshops will take place in Yellowknife, all materials and snacks will be provided but participants are responsible for any travel or accommodation costs.

The schedule is:

September 24th: **Science Fun**- Learn simple science experiments to do with kids and fun books to read with the experiment!

October 29th: **Book Making**- Making books is fun and it gives children an opportunity to tell their own stories. Come learn several books you can make with students!

November 26th: **StorySacks**- A StorySack is a bag full of props, backdrop and activities to go along with a book. In this workshop we will create StorySacks for you to take back to your program. (Advanced preparation required.)

January 21st: **Little Chefs**- Cooking together is a fun way to practice early numeracy skills! Come learn fun ways to incorporate books, crafts and safe cooking with kids.

February 18th: **Digital Storytelling**- Digital stories are a way to tell a story in any language using photos, voice recordings and songs. You will learn how to use the technology and how to create your own digital story. (Laptop and advanced preparation required.)

March 24th: **Story Time Adventures**- These are thematic sessions of crafts, songs, and activities based around a book. Workshop participants will have an opportunity to do one session of the manual together.

Registration for all of the workshops is required two weeks before the workshop. Participants will then receive confirmation with details on time, location and if there is any advanced preparation.
