NWT Literacy Council Regional Literacy Funding Guidelines and Application Form

Purpose of the Regional Literacy Funds

- To support local community literacy activities

Eligibility

- Groups eligible for funding include community not-for-profit organizations (NGOs), schools and libraries.

Eligible projects include:

1. Community literacy activities sponsored by libraries, NGOs and schools
2. Family literacy activities such as Reading Circles, Literacy and Parenting, Books in the Home, etc.
3. Aboriginal language literacy activities
4. School-based literacy activities
5. Special activities within adult literacy programs

Project Costs

- Funding is limited to a maximum of \$500.00 per project
- The purchase of books must be linked to an actual literacy activity such as Reading Circles, Books in the Home, etc.
- Computer equipment is not eligible for funding

Proposal Review

- NWT Literacy Council Regional Representatives will review the proposals.
